Members:

- All Members have training, mentorship, and career opportunities with the Organization

Volunteers:

These are individuals who offer their time, skills, and efforts on a voluntary basis to support the Organization's work. Volunteers have varying levels of involvement, from occasional





participation in specific projects to more regular commitments.

As a Volunteer, you do not typically have the formal rights and responsibilities associated with Membership, such as voting or decision-making authority. However, a Volunteer has the opportunity at any point in time to graduate to becoming a Member by fulfilling our Membership Requirements.

- May participate in decision-making processes.

- As a Volunteer, you have the choice of flexibility: Volunteers can choose when and how much time they want to commit, making it easier to balance with other commitments.
- Volunteers often have fewer administrative or organizational responsibilities unlike Members, allowing them to focus on hands-on work.

Steps to becoming a Member of the Institution

To become a member, you are required to fulfill the First Order of the Institution. The First Order is a spiritual obligation for all intending members. It entails getting up within the hours of 12:00am – 3:00am to pray in the Spirit for a minimum of 45 minutes daily for seven (7) days. A separate form will be given to this effect to register day and time of this obligation.

- Every Member is required to join at least one department within the Institution.
